



# Simply Slim - my226X

While treading similar territory to Sagem's my220X and my150X, this handset aims for a slightly more sophisticated market. While it is also priced in the lower market tier, the my226X's silky, all-black design is sleeker and more fashionable.

A tactile finish has been used for the rear, which makes it feel different. And a polished-mirror finish has been used on its front. As with many higher-end fashion products, this glistens when light hits it and grabs your attention. That makes this handset pretty trendy for its price.

Consumers will also appreciate its shape and slimness. At barely 10 mm in depth, this product resembles a Nokia

monoblock on a diet. Its colour screen is fairly compact, though it is large enough to handle basic functions.

Appreciating a trend toward simplicity, functions are once again at the basic end of the spectrum. Recognising its older demographic, it includes mind-puzzling Sudoku and a decent calendar to help waste - then re-organise - your time. Using a scroll-through menu, this handset can make calls and send SMS with ease.
